Voters will choose one ballot from the *3 following ballot choices:

<p><u>Ballot with candidates and measures:</u></p> <p>Candidates from: Alaska Democratic Party, Alaska Libertarian Party and Alaskan Independence Party</p>	Any registered voter
<p><u>Ballot with candidates and measures</u></p> <p>Candidates from: Alaska Republican Party</p>	<p>Voters registered with political affiliation Alaska Republican, Undeclared or Nonpartisan</p> <p>(Voters must be registered as Republican, Undeclared, or Nonpartisan at least 30 days before the election)</p>
<p><u>Ballot with only measures</u></p> <p>No Candidates <i>*There will be a measures only ballot if there are ballot measures on the ballot.</i></p>	Any registered voter
